TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The following terms and conditions apply to all companies and or persons or

other entities (“you”) who attend a JustinGuitar workshop (“Workshop”) organised by JustinGuitar Ltd (Co. No. 6589840) of 315 Chiswick High Rd, London W4 4HH (“we” or “us”). Please ensure you have read and understand the following:

1. Acceptance of terms and conditions

By completing the registration form for a particular workshop, you are agreeing to the terms and conditions set out below (“**Terms**”) and they will be incorporated into the contract between us (“**Contract**”). You will ensure that your employees, partners, agents, contractors, subcontractors and any other person attending the Workshop on your behalf shall comply with these Terms. The Contract is formed when we send you a booking confirmation.

2. Registration

Please complete the registration form on our website. Once received by us we will check availability for the Workshop and will confirm your place (subject to availability) by email to you. Details of our workshops and course content for each can be found on our website at <https://www.justinguitarworkshops.com>.

3. Payment

If we confirm that there is a place available for you on the Workshop, the fee for attending the Workshop is shown on our website (“**Registration Fee**”). Prices are inclusive of VAT except where expressly stated otherwise. A deposit of £250 (including VAT, if any) (“**Deposit**”) must be paid once we have confirmed to by email that there is a place available for you on the Workshop. The balance (“**Balance**”) must be paid by you no later than 40 days prior to the date of the Workshop. If the Deposit is not received within 7 days of your registration or if the Balance is not paid at least 40 days prior to the date of the Workshop, your registration will be cancelled and the payment of any refund will be at our complete discretion. The Deposit must be made via PayPal to account: tour@justinguitar.com (and you consent to us passing your necessary details to PayPal and to them processing necessary information about you). The Balance must be made using bank transfer. We shall provide you with our bank account details to where such transfer must be made. **The Registration Fee does not include the cost of flights, travel and accommodation, for which you are separately liable (see below).**

4. Accommodation

The Workshop is a residential workshop and will take place at the hotel shown on the relevant Workshop webpage (“**Hotel**”). We have reserved rooms for those attending the Workshop, but it is your responsibility to book and pay for your accommodation for the duration of your stay. Please see links on the relevant

We are pleased to confirm that the owners of the Hotel have agreed to provide attendees with a special discounted rate which costs include welcome drink on arrival, accommodation for 6 nights, 6 breakfasts, 6 dinners and 5 lunches.

5. Flights and Arrival

You are responsible for booking and paying for flights to and from Italy and for ground transportation to and from the airport and the Hotel. It is your responsibility to ensure that you arrive at the Hotel between 4pm and 6pm on the first day of the Workshop, as the initial meeting is at 6pm, where you will meet your teacher and fellow students. If you wish to arrive a day earlier, please let us know and we will inform the Hotel so that they can reserve an additional night's accommodation for you (subject to availability, and at your expense). Please allow for plenty of journey time to arrive at the Hotel. If you are late at the workshop or prevented from attending the Workshop due to travel delays or any other circumstances, we shall not be obliged to provide you with a refund or to wait to start the Workshop until you arrive.

6. Refunds

All payments for the Workshop shall be non-refundable except as set out in paragraphs 7 and 8 below. However, if you are unable to attend the Workshop for any reason you may email us at roberti.carlo@gmail.com to provide us with the name of a substitute to attend the Workshop on your behalf and on receipt of this email we shall make such substitution and allow the substitute access to the Workshop. We may at our discretion charge an administration fee of up to £50 for making such substitution.

7. Cancellation

There may be circumstances in which we need to cancel the Workshop. In the unlikely event that we have to cancel the Workshop, we will provide you with a full refund of the amount of the Registration Fee that you have paid to us within 30 days of the date of cancellation.

8. Postponement or change to venue

There may be circumstances in which we need to postpone the Workshop, change any of the teachers or change the venue at which Workshop is to be held and if we do, we shall advise you of this as soon as we possibly can. In such event, you shall have the option of withdrawing from the Workshop and obtaining a full refund of the Registration Fee that you have paid, but please note that should this happen we will not accept any liability in relation to any travel and/or accommodation

expenses incurred by you.

9. Liability and Disclaimer – important, you must read this

Our sole liability in relation to any cancellation, postponement or change of venue shall be limited to the Registration Fee paid by you for the Workshop and we shall not be liable under any circumstances for any consequential losses.

We shall be entitled to pass on all of your contact details to the Workshop contractors. We shall not send you tickets for the Workshop. We will have your name on the attendee list and if you have paid the Registration Fee you shall be provided with access to the Workshop.
